Existing circuits shall be migrated to the new grading system upon licence renewal or upon request of the ASN.

The FIA shall define the grading required when inviting ASNs to submit applications for entering a circuit on the calendar of an FIA Karting Championship, Cup or Trophy.

NOTE 1:

[Karting Light Panels, either in compliance with FIA Standard 3506-2024 or non-FIA approved, are mandatory for new Grade 1 and Grade 2 circuits homologated in 2025, as well as for existing Grade 1 and Grade 2 circuits whose circuit license is renewed in 2025.](#)

[Karting Circuit Light Panels in compliance with FIA Standard 3506-2024 will be mandatory from 1 January 2026 for new circuits.](#)

[Circuits that have their CIK-FIA license issued or renewed in 2025 will be required to use Karting Circuit Light Panels in compliance with FIA Standard 3506-2024 no later than 1 January 2029.](#)
